Dr. Kim has 10+ years of experience in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, has performed over 3,000 arches of AOX procedures, and has placed more than 15,000 implants. She has written numerous book chapters and papers on various topics in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Dr. Kim has expertise and presented nationally on advanced techniques such as pterygoid implants. She has received numerous academic and clinical recognitions including Top Dentist by Boston Magazine, the Harvard University Presidential Scholarship, and the Howard Hughes Medical Institute Research Training Fellowship.
